Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to your online application no. EX-02219-1819 executed on dated 22.06.2017 and subsequent inspection report submitted by the Member on the above subject. In this connection, in view of the observations of the Inspection Committee, the following deficiencies have been observed:

1. The school is required to construct Pucca Boundary Wall
2. Student strength of school need to be improved
3. Maintenance of Lab & Library required
4. Broadband service not available.
5. School should develop proper Computer Science Lab with adequate no. of computer in good conditions.
6. There are insufficient equipment & apparatus in Physics, Chemistry & Biology Lab
7. Books were not sufficient in Library
8. The school is required to submit copies of renewed certificates of fire safety building, health, health Sanitation and safe drinking water duly issued from concerned/competent authority of the State Government.
9. The school is required to submit a certificate/proof (of salary) issued/certified from Competent Authority/Education Department of the State, to the effect that the school is paying salaries and other allowances to its staff as per State/Central Govt norms along with copy of acquaintance-roll with complete details of all staff i.e. name, designation, pay with salary details etc.
10. Service books of the staff not maintained. School is required to maintain service books of the staff.
11. The school is required to submit certificates of Grievance Redressal Mechanism and protection of children from sexual offences Act 2012 & The sexual harassment of women in workplace Act 2013
12. The school is required to appoint experienced Principal.
13. The school is required to submit the copy of Compact Land Certificate of Land (as per appendix VI of affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board) duly certified by Competent Authority (i.e. Sub-Registrar, Tensidar/District Magistrate etc.) to the board, as per the boards norms.
14. The school is required to maintain FDR of reserve fund in the joint names of the Principal of the school and Managing Trustee/Member of the Society/trust/Company etc. (bearing the name of the school) according to the strength of the students/norms of the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board. Submit a copy of the same.
15. There are 25 teacher against 18 sections. The school is required to appoint teachers on permanent basis who are trained and qualified as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of Board to maintain section teacher ratio i.e. 1.5 teachers per section at each level. Half copy of revised staff statement is required to be submitted showing Name, Qualification, Designation, Date of Appointment, Date of Confirmation, classes assigned, experience etc.

It may be ensured that the documents forwarded to the Board will be signed by the Manager and Principal of the school.

Conditions for which Compliance to be submitted with in three months from the date of issue of sanction letter :-

1. Running /Starting of class IX/X or XI/XII without prior Provisional Affiliation upto Secondary level /Sr. Secondary level from the Board would be unauthorised and school shall be responsible for the consequences arising out of it.
2. Non submission of application for extension of Provisional Affiliation by 30th June of the year preceding to the year by which provisional affiliation granted, expires, would also attract violation of provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws.
3. School will not prepare any student/start any class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE Affiliated school Building/premises.
4. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one Society /Management / Trust to another Society / Management / Trust through agreement /sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effects.
5. Pay and allowances to staff should be revised from time to time to bring it at par with that to the State Government.
6. The service conditions be strictly followed as per State Education Act and staff be given appointment / Confirmation letters etc. accordingly.
7. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee. Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV
8. The School shall maintain Section teacher Ratio at least 1:1:5 at each level i.e. primary (I-V) Secondary (VI-X) and Sr. secondary (XI-XII)
9. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of women from sexual harrasment at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No. 666-70 of 1992 Vishakha and others state of Rajasthan and others delivered on 13/08/1997.

1. The School is required to follow syllabi and course as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for the respective Examination.
2. The School is required to abide itself by the Examination/Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board.
3. The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation alongwith the requisite fee and other documents by 30th June of the preceding year in which the Provisional Affiliation expires. Applications will be accepted after the last date along with the prescribed fee and late fee Rs. 10,000 per month. (Amended Rule 15.11)
4. Provisional Affiliation granted to a school will remain valid on receipt of online application of a school for further extension of provisional affiliation subject to the final decision of the Board. (Amended Rule 15.11)
5. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII :-

7. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc.
8. Income & Expenditure and audited annual accounts statement duly certified by the Chartered Accountant for the current year is required to be sent and the same be submitted every year.
9. Other conditions are enclosed as per Annexure 'A'.
10. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-

- i) The school is required to renew Certificates regarding availability of Fire Safety, Safe Drinking Water and Sanitary conditions, etc.
- ii) The School Managing Committee has not been constituted as per Affiliation Bye-Laws, therefore, it may be reconstituted by including representatives of teachers, parents and CBSE.
- iii) The School is not paying salary to the staff as per Affiliation Bye-laws. The staff be paid salary at least at par with the salary of corresponding category employees working in State Government schools.
- iv) Efforts should be made by the school to increase the number of students in I-V and Senior Secondary classes.
